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HOW TO START

1.1 De needed contact details

First, we need some of your details to contact you. This will be done with skype so we can speak and see the beavers. We will make a beaver group to which all of you will be invited

Furthermore, we want your address so we can send some props for the activities. The props will be brought next to your doorstep.

1.2 Where to send your details

1.3 For the beavers

For the beavers there will be a tick-off chart. You can print this so your child can look at the available activities and choose one. You can choose when or how many activities you do. The more activities you do the more change you have to get an insignia.

1.4 Contact with the beaver leaders

You can talk to the beaver leaders during the second half of when there should be a normal meeting (Saturday 10:30 till 11:30). This will be done with skype. Here you can ask questions and show us how many and which activities you have done. The props that would be brought will also show up around this time. In case you don't have a printer at home we can print it and send it with the first package. The first package will arrive on April 18th.

1.5 Friends

We would love to see some friends of the beavers. That's why you can do the activities with some (not many) friends.

2 ACTIVITIES

2.1 Describe your surroundings

The beaver leaders want to know how you live. Let your child describe your house/area with drawings or some pictures, bonus point for a fun description with the pictures/drawings. When you have done this, you can show it to the beaver leaders and describe the pictures.

2.2 Cooking with Rozemarijn

Your child may know this already, but Rozemarijn loves cooking. We have some recipes from her cookbook that you can use to cook some food. These are:

Apple sauce:

ingredients:

- 3-4 apples
- 40 grams of sugar
- 50 ml of water

How many apples you need depends on the size of the apples, but it doesn't matter if you have some more or less for the results.

Preparation:

Peel the apples, remove the core and cut in them into pieces. Put them in a pan with some sugar and boil them. Let them boil for 10 minutes.

Stir occasionally.



Sand cookies:

ingredients:

- 200 grams of flour
- 75 grams of sugar
- 1 egg yolk
- 1 vanilla sugar package
- 125 grams of butter
- 1 1 spoon of cold water

Necessities

- Baking sheet with baking paper
- Rolling pin
- Shapes



Put the flour, sugar and vanilla sugar in a bowl. Next put in the butter in cubes also put in the egg yolk. Mix until it is a crumbly dough. Add one spoon of water and knead the dough with your hands till it is a tough ball. If it is too dry then add some water, if it is too sticky add some flour. Put the dough in cooking foil and let it rest in the fridge for half an hour. When the dough is cold you will get a better result and it is easier to make shapes. Preheat the oven to 175 degrees.

After at least half an hour, get the flour out of the foil. Put Flour on your workspace and roll the dough out with the rolling pin. Cut shapes of the dough with cookie cutters or a knife and lay them on a baking sheet with baking paper. Make sure there is enough space between the cookies. Put the cookies in the oven and bake them for about 15 minutes until gold brown. Then let the cookies cool off and then you can eat them

Cake:

Ingredients:

- 200 grams of butter
- 200 grams of self-rising flour
- 200 grams of
- 8 grams of vanilla sugar
- 4 eggs
- A pinch of salt

Necessities

- Baking mould

Preheat the oven on it is 175 degrees. Mix the butter, sugar, vanilla sugar and the salt in a creamy mix. Add the eggs one for and mix for a smooth mixture. Add the self-rising flour slowly. Keep mixing till you have a batter. Put the batter in a buttered baking mould. Bake the cake for 60 minutes (on 175 degrees) till it is gold brown. After it is done let it cool down before you eat it.

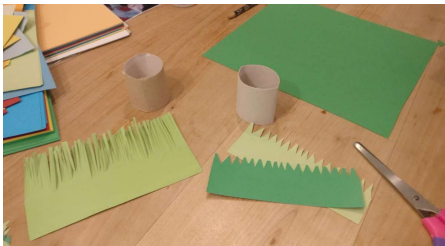
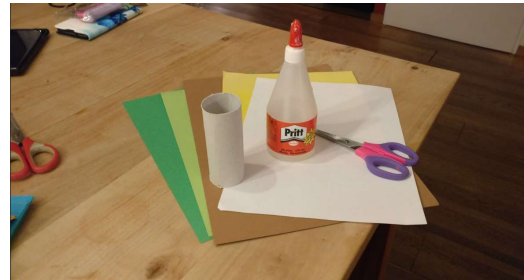


2.6 Making an egg holder



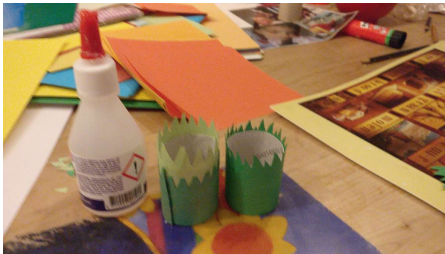
It's almost Easter, and with Easter you need eggs. But where do you put your eggs? It's nice for decoration on the windowsill, your own egg holder! This is what you need for your own egg holder:

- One (empty) toilet paper roll
- glue
- one scissor
- paper in different colors
- pencils, pens and markers.
- stickers and other decorations



To begin you need to cut your toilet paper roll in half, for the grass you can cut the paper. The paper needs to cover the girth of the roll and be high enough to cover its height. You can use coloured paper or just white paper coloured in or decorated with your pencils, pens and markers. When you have done this cut the top of so the top looks like blades of grass

When you have done this, you can glue the grass around the roll, and you have finished the first part



Now you can decorate your egg holder with a bunny, a chicken or even a dinosaur. Anything goes. First, draw the animal, then draw the details such as eyes, mouths or beaks.

Glue the creation behind the egg holder so the animal looks at you, you can look at the pictures for examples. We would like to see what you can make!
